

Energy Save sells mobile heat pump modules to EI-Björn

ES Energy Save Holding AB (publ) has, via the subsidiary ES Systems AB, signed an agreement with EI-Björn for the delivery of heat pump modules during 2023 with a total order value of approx. SEK 6 million. The agreement is a direct consequence of a multi-year cooperation agreement between the parties.

Energy Save and EI-Björn have collaborated for several years in product and business development. Before today's agreement, EI-Björn had acquired five plug-in modules for use on construction sites.

- I have experience from the construction industry and have seen the great potential for Energy Save's heat pump technology for temporary needs, not least when it comes to drying and heating on construction sites. It feels very good to, together with EI-Björn, be able to offer our technology to construction companies that want to build in a more sustainable way, says Niklas Hansson who is project and business development manager at Energy Save.

The agreement is signed between Energy Save and EI-Björn AB for the ePOLE business area. ePOLE offers sustainable services within temporary energy solutions and energy efficiency.

- Just like Energy Save, we want to influence future energy use. At EI-Björn we have been intensifying our environmental work for the past five years and a concrete result of that is the establishment of our new business area and brand ePOLE. With this agreement, we are intensifying our work in Sweden, Norway and Finland to contribute to the climate and energy transition in the real estate, construction and energy sectors, says Daniel Segerqvist, who is market and business development manager at EI-Björn.

The agreement applies to the air/water pump ES HeatBox Hydro 90 with the capacity to deliver heat up to 120 kW. The advantage compared to other heating solutions is that Energy Save's module is mobile, flexible and easy to install and provides reduced costs and CO2 emissions.
